In addition, the event will create opportunities for agriculture, forestry, fisheries, and food businesses in Kyoto Prefecture to utilize foodtech, and will also gather information on foodtech for Kyoto Prefecture to become a hub for foodtech businesses in Japan in the future.

Startups that are involved in innovation in the food value chain and are considering or currently developing business or R&D in Kyoto Prefecture

## 7 Screening Criteria

Projects will be judged comprehensively based on the following criteria (1) through (7).

(1) Theme (conformity with the theme of the competition), (2) Novelty (no similar business), (3) Originality (novel point of view), (4) Potential (business growth potential), (5) Marketability (business needs and profitability potential), (6) Presenter's enthusiasm (presentation, Q&A session, etc.), and (7) Contribution to Kyoto Prefecture (potential to contribute to food-related industries in Kyoto Prefecture).

## (a) Preliminary Screening

Approximately 10 teams will be selected to participate in the next Pitch Contest based on a document review of the plans submitted via the entry form.
